To Americans, our horses represent a symbol of the American spirit. They are beautiful and noble animals with big hearts who have served us so well. To the French, our horses represent dinner. They are slaughtered, often under cruel conditions, and then sent overseas for human consumption. There are two remaining slaughterhouses in this country. They are both foreign-owned: one French, the other Belgian.

Last year alone 49,325 American horses were butchered.

That number will go higher this year unless you help.
